

Addendum to the Memorandum of Understanding and Cooperation

between

National Taiwan Sport University, Taiwan

and

Semmelweis University, Hungary

Article 1

Under this Addendum, each academic year, both University, may send up to three students for a year of study or its equivalence. The number of students sent and received in each academic year will be identical and the exact number of participants will be determined yearly by the National Taiwan Sport University and Semmelweis University's Faculty of Physical Education and Sport Sciences.

Article 2

Students accepted under this addendum shall be exempt from paying tuition fees to the host institution, which tuition fees shall be paid to their home institution. However, they may be required to pay an administration fee to either or both the host institution and their home institution. The host institution will also responsible for students' lodging.

Article 3

The cost of accommodation, transportation, textbooks, medical insurance, and all other personal needs shall be the responsibility of individual students.

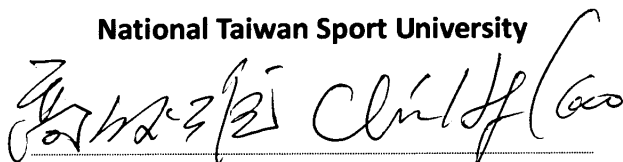
Article 4

Both institutions are to establish a joint mechanism for the support of faculty exchanges and collaboration between the two institutions. Faculty exchanges may encompass teaching and/or cooperative research.

Article 5

This Addendum shall take effect within the period of Memorandum and may be automatically renewed for successive five years unless either party gives the other written notice of its desire to terminate or to revise the Addendum twelve months prior to the expiry of this Addendum.

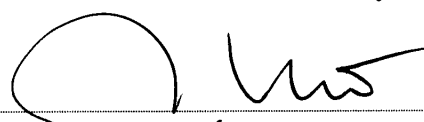
