

MEMORANDUM ON STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Between

National Taiwan Sport University

and

Korea National Sport University

*Through friendly discussion, National Taiwan Sport University
and Korea National Sport University joins in the following Memorandum
on Student Exchange Program*

According to the Agreement on Exchange and Cooperation between National Taiwan Sport University (NTSU) and Korea National Sport University (KNSU), both universities will encourage exchange and cooperation between students based on the provisions of the memorandum. NTSU and KNSU shall cooperate in the fields reciprocally. This memorandum is construed as statements to foster genuine and mutually beneficial academic collaboration. Specific details follow:

Definition

Both universities agree to host exchange programs annually. Both NTSU and KNSU will mutually deliver one foundationer for the exchange program. In addition, both universities can also send other recommended non-foundationers, defined as students at their own expenses. The length of the exchange program is one year. Both universities accept the credits and academic hours of the exchange program.

Applicant Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must be students currently enrolled at the two universities. The foundationers are selected based on the foundationer selection criteria defined by the two universities.

Enrollment Quota

Host universities will admit one foundationer yearly. The tuition and miscellaneous expenses are waived for foundationers. Both NTSU and KNSU agree to accept several recommended non-foundationers for the exchange programs. These non-foundationers are responsible for their tuition and miscellaneous expenses.

Language

Courses are delivered in the native languages of the host countries. Exchange students should have the basic understanding of the languages of the host countries. Exchange students are required to submit language proficiency reports along with their applications.

Tuition and Miscellaneous expenses

All exchange students must pay tuition and miscellaneous expenses to their home universities or keep their student eligibilities at the home universities. Host universities will provide room and board for foundationers. Foundationers are responsible for their own living expenses. Non-foundationers are responsible for their room and board and living expenses; however, the host universities shall reserve the rights for the exchange students. Host universities will not charge fees for application, enrollment, and lectures.

Exchange students are responsible for their fees of visa, travel, and personal expenses including books, insurance, and medical examination, etc. Host universities will not be responsible for the above mentioned fees.

Credits and Transcript

One month after the registration of courses, the host universities must submit students' registered course list (English/Chinese, English/Korean) to the exchange students' home universities. In addition, the host universities must submit students' official transcripts (English/Chinese, English/Korean) one month after the completion of the exchange program.

Registration

Exchange students shall arrive the host universities one week prior to the date of registration. Students will be welcomed by the international exchange center of the host universities.

Relevant Regulation

Exchange students must obey the laws and regulations of the host countries and the host universities.

Validity

This memorandum is written in three languages, Chinese, English, and Korean. The three versions are equally recognized.

Expiration

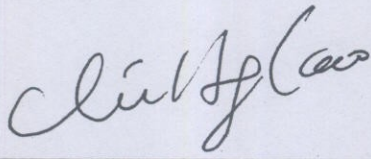
This memorandum will become effective upon the date of signature by the presidents of the two universities. It shall be subject to review in five years and shall be extended upon mutual agreement. The memorandum shall remain effective unless either university gives written notification of discontinuance. The written notification shall be delivered 6 months prior to the expiration date. The memorandum will be

- formally terminated when exchange students complete the program.

Other Related Articles

Any articles in this memorandum may be amended or revised by the two universities after consultation and mutual agreement.

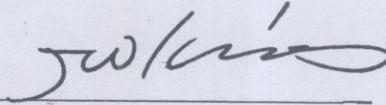
Any issues not mentioned in this memorandum must be resolved through mutual agreement.
