National Taiwan Sport University, is a public university accredited in Taiwan, Ministry of Education with authority to offer undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate degrees described in its catalogue through traditional and distance learning programs.

Semmelweis University, is approved as an institution of higher education located in Budapest, Hungary, established to offer quality educational programs to its student population. Semmelweis University is legally accredited by the independent board of the National Accreditation Committee of Hungary with the certification of the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Health.

United by their mutual interest in the service of diverse student populations; the development of innovative international educational programs; academic offerings of the highest integrity; the expansion of cooperative cultural interactions between **Hungary and Taiwan**; and the furtherance of the missions and purposes of their institutions, **National Taiwan Sport University**, and **Semmelweis University**, agree to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding and Cooperation (MOUC).

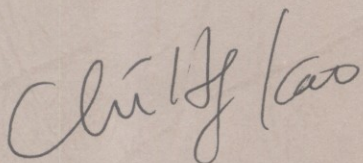
1. **Purposes & Objectives.** The purposes and objectives of the parties entering into this MOUC are to negotiate and develop cooperative projects as a means of coordinating educational activities between the institutions:
 - Create mechanisms for the exchange of the teaching and research staff, and undergraduate students majoring in sport sciences.
 - Prepare a culturally competent international sport science workforce.
 - Negotiate and develop collaborative efforts in the areas of academic programming, common projects, assessment and evaluation.
2. **Support & Resources.** To accomplish the purposes and objectives stated in this MOUC, the institutions agree to provide support in mutually agreed amounts for:
 - a. Conduct of discussions to fulfill the purposes and objectives identified above.
 - b. Cooperation between the institutions for the development of projects in mutually agreed areas.
 - c. Identification of professional staff engaged in parallel technical, educational, and managerial functions at the institutions in support of such discussions and cooperation.

Each institution will endeavor to allocate and provide sufficient resources, including personnel, infrastructure, equipment, and material, necessary to conduct activities associated with this MOUC. The institutions will negotiate and agree in writing the payment of expenses incurred by its personnel participating in such activities before entering into action (transportation, hotel, meals, per diem, etc.).

3. **Coordinators.** Each institution will designate a coordinator who will regularly communicate and cooperate with the coordinator of the other institution. The coordinators will jointly:
 - a. Submit to both institutions a general plan to accomplish the purposes and objectives of this MOUC. Such a plan, along with additional, definitive documentation associated with the agreement, will be subject to the written approval of each institution.
 - b. Supervise implementation activities associated with projects initiated by the institutions.
 - c. Evaluate approved projects on a regular basis.
 - d. Present to the institutions reports on the results achieved from approved projects, providing detailed information concerning the objectives of the projects.
 - e. Administer and be responsible for the progress of this MOUC on behalf of the respective institutions.
4. **Communication.** The institutions will regularly communicate with the intent of achieving the purposes and objectives of this MOUC and to reduce the risk of misunderstandings between the institutions during the term of this MOUC.
5. **Effect and Term of MOUC.** This MOUC will become effective only after it is approved by both institutions and signed by an authorized representative of each institution. The term of this MOUC will commence upon signature and will continue for a period of five (5) years, unless sooner terminated in accordance with the following sentence. Either party may upon 90 days written notice to the other party terminate this MOUC without penalty.
6. **Non-Disclosure Agreement.** In the course of their dialogue, **National Taiwan Sport University**, and **Semmelweis University**, will exchange confidential and proprietary information. The institutions agree that they will not communicate to any person or entity in any manner whatsoever any portion of the other party's proprietary information or trade secrets, except as required by law or at the request of their accrediting authorities. This provision not to divulge, disclose or communicate confidential and proprietary information shall survive beyond the termination of the agreement, and shall be enforceable at any time thereafter. Immediately upon termination of this agreement, the institutions commit to return and deliver all documents or other materials which contain confidential proprietary information and/or trade secrets to the exclusive control of the other party.

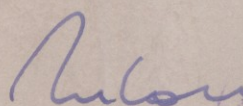
7. **Duplicate Originals.** Duplicate originals of this MOUC have been completed in English language only. The Partners have the authority to translate this MOUC into their language of origin, although they acknowledge that fact that in case of misunderstanding, the English language version will prevail. The Partners retain one signed copy of this MOUC.

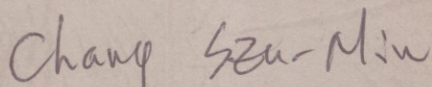

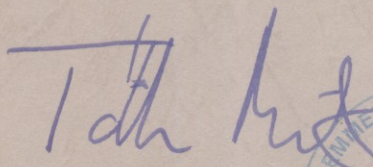
